## Service Notes

- → CSPDC staff attended the TSDAC meeting virtually on October 8.
- → On October 9, CSPDC staff hosted an Afton Express pop-up event at the Waynesboro Park and Ride Lot.
- → CSPDC staff attended a FTA Civil Rights meeting on October 10, and an FTA Safety Management Systems Training Session on October 23- both were held virtually.
- → On October 30, CSPDC staff attended a VDOT Field Inspection meeting for the SMART SCALE BRITE Pedestrian Improvement Project.
- → A virtual kick-off meeting for the BRITE Bus Microtransit Feasibility Study was held on October 31 with staff from the CSPDC and Kimley-Horn.
- → Winter Hours for the Staunton Downtown Trolley and Saturday Night Trolley began on November 1 and will be effective until May 1.
- → BRITE routes (excluding Afton Express) were fare-free on Election Day, November 5.
- → CSPDC staff gave a BRITE Bus presentation to Staunton Citizen's University on November 6.
- → CSPDC staff attended a virtual DRPT Grantee Workshop on November 13.
- → The regularly scheduled and annual BRITE Transit Advisory Committee lunch and meeting was held on November 13 at the BRITE Transit Facility, and the CSPDC hosted the regularly scheduled Afton Express Partners meeting on November 25.
- → In observance of the Thanksgiving holiday, there was no BRITE or Afton Express service on November 27, and no Afton Express service on November 28.
- → The BRITE Transit Facility monthly inspections were completed on October 3 and November 7
- → Delays/route modifications due to weather, mechanical issues, traffic/accidents/road closures, special events, or unforeseen circumstances were experienced:
- → October 4: Waynesboro Circulator; October 16: Downtown Trolley; October 25: BRCC Shuttles
- → November 9: Downtown Trolley; November 25: BRCC Shuttles; November 30: Staunton Downtown Trolley

## Service Changes

Beginning November 1, the Staunton West/North Loops and Downtown Trolley implemented new route and schedule changes. The West/North Loops now operate as a 1-hour loop, rather than 2, 30-minute loops. Additionally, a CALL stop was added at Middlebrook Trace Apartments, and the new hours are Mon-Fri, 6:30AM-7:30PM and Sat, 7:30AM-5:30PM. The Staunton Downtown Trolley also added three stops previously on the North/West Loops (Booker T. Washington Comm Center; Walnut St/Montgomery Ave; Sudbury St/W Johnson St).
